Prayer of Dependence

Father, I want to learn to trust You with my life and the problems I am right now facing. I choose to embrace this difficulty and to make the most out of it so that not one day will be wasted. I say, "not my will, but Yours!" I want to learn to trust You right now. I am Your child. I give You this difficult situation and I lay it before You. [Give the Lord whatever difficulty you are facing.]

Take the striving out of my life and the self-sufficiency in my heart. Help me not to make my own plans and then ask You to bless them. Teach me to listen to You and then do Your will wholeheartedly. Show me Your plan for today and help me to live it out joyfully. I am blessed because of You.

Jesus, forgive me for the times where I have forced my own plans and will, and change me to be one who lays everything at Your feet. I want to give You my time and my devotion. I give You my hours of solitude, and I make it my choice to be in Your presence and to practice hour-by-hour dependence on You.

God, convict me whenever I go my own way. I choose to do it Your way now. I acknowledge my total dependence on You at this moment. All that I have is Yours and belongs to You. All my rights of ownership are Yours; I am a steward of the blessings in my life. You are all I need. I am under Your leadership. Take my weakness and sustain me. You know how to manage my life perfectly.
