## Conversations in Community

Below are the definitions of several words used in the message today, what do they mean to you?

**righteousness** /'riCHəsənəs/ noun

the quality of being morally right or justifiable

**justice** /'jəstəs/ noun

just behavior or treatment; administration of the law

synonyms: fairness, equity, impartiality, objectivity, neutrality

**mercy** /'mɜrsē/ noun

compassion or forgiveness shown toward someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm
